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ANALYSIS OF PINOCCHIO CHARACTER IN PINOCCHIO (2022) MOVIE

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KEYWORDS ABSTRACT Main Character, The purpose of this study is to describe the main character in Pinocchio (2022) movie. This type Movie. of research is qualitative descriptive or this research is dialog and scenes that show character in the Pinocchio (2022), main character. The data source in this research is Pinocchio (2022) movie by Chris Weitz. This movie is an adaptation of the previous movie entitled Pinocchio (1940). The method used in this research is qualitative description by using Robert Stanton's character analysis theory (1965). The data collection technique uses watching, listening, classifying, analyzing, and concluding data. The results of the analysis show that the character of the main character Pinocchio contained in the movie Pinocchio (2022) are; disobedient character (8), loving character (5), obedient character (5), curious character (4), naive character (4), cheerful character (1), worrying character (4), lying character (4), brave character (2), friendly character (3), intelligent character (2), optimistic character (2), responsible character (2), helpful character (1), and fearful character (1). The most dominant character of Pinocchio is the dissident character. Meanwhile, the characters that were least encountered by the researcher were cheerful, helpful, and fearful. The results of this study reveal that the Pinocchio (2022) movie is child-friendly and safe from harmful meanings that may be implied in the movie. However, there is also a need for parental supervision.

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INTRODUCTION

Literary works are art performed through language. Literary works have two functions, namely to educate and entertain. According to Greil Marcus and Werner Sollor (2009) says that literary means not only what is written but what is voiced, what is expressed, what is invented, in whatever form. Literature makes social life and the real world an object. Literary works themselves consist of various forms, namely poetry, prose, and drama.

In addition to novels, poems, short stories and dramas, there are also movies. Movie is a form of mass communication, where the delivery of messages is sent from visual and audio elements and then combined into a medium to convey entertainment, education, and social information. Movie is also a creative art of someone who makes the movie itself. Movies have a creative ability because movies are able to describe the reality that exists imaginary images that are able to entertain and become a reflection for the audience. Hornby (2005) explains that a movie is a series of moving images recorded with sound that tells a story that is shown on television or in a cinema or theater. According to Sapp (1986), movies are moving images that are considered as a source of entertainment or as an art form. Movies not only tell stories or provide entertainment but also provide unique and interesting works of art because of the ideas expressed in the form of live images.

Movies have a stronger influence in influencing people's thoughts than other media because in movies there are characters and storylines that can touch the hearts of the audience. One of the most important elements for the success of a movie is the character. A character in a movie is not an actual person but an image that the writer has created in a special way. After the writer selects several aspects of human traits, he or she chooses a few that he or she deems suitable and then combines them into a character. The character created may be interesting and make us react to the character as we would react to a real person, but in reality, we react according to how the character was created. In a movie, there are several actors who run the movie, namely main and additional characters, protagonists and antagonists, simple characters and round characters, static characters and developing characters, typical characters and neutral characters.

The main character in a movie is very influential. The main character is the character who is prioritized in a story. The main character is the character who is told the most and is present in every incident. The main character is always said to be a protagonist who has a good character. Every character or actor who plays a movie has a different character. Character is the inner nature that influences all thoughts, behaviors, manners, and habits of humans or other living things. The main character always has a good nature, does not give up easily with the situation and continues to fight. According to Grill (1995: 127) main characters are characters who play an important, dominant and high-intensity role in every conflict that builds a story, and they are also usually complex and fully developed. The main character is always associated as a protagonist who has a good character. Every character who plays a movie has a different character.

According to Roberts Stanton in his book An Introduction to Fiction (1965: 17) can refer to individuals in the story or in other words character or story also refers to the unity of interests, emotions and moral principles that make up the character or in other words describes the behavior or nature of the story. In analyzing character, Stanton says the most important thing is dialogue and behavior. In good fiction, every word, every action not only determines the plot, but is also the embodiment of character (1965: 18). In analyzing the main character in Robert Stanton's research, he categorizes several parts, namely Character's words, Character's Behavior, Conversations between Characters, and Characters Action.

Character's words, the researcher gives the reader insight into the character through the character's words. The researcher presents several clues about the character, namely when the character speaks or the character is in conversation with others as well as whenever the character expresses his opinion.

Character's Behavior, the researcher describes a person's behavior such as habits or idiosyncrasies that may also tell the reader something about the main character.

Conversations between Characters, the researcher gives some clues about a person's character through their conversations with other people and the things they say when people talk about other people. The things they often say will give clues about a person's character.

Characters Action, the researcher gives the reader clues about a person's character by describing to the reader how a person reacts to certain situations and conditions.

The main character has been a research for a long time. Previous research to be conducted by Rizky Tungga. T. T. with his thesis journal entitled Main Character Analysis and Author's Life Description in Charles Dickens' David Copperfiels Novel. In this thesis journal, the researcher focuses on analyzing the main character in David Copperfield's novel. The researcher used Robert Stanton's theory (1965) to identify and analyze the main character through words, behaviors, conversations, and actions. The results of this study show that the main character's personality is diligent, rigid, innocent, hardworking, romantic, loyal and loving. Different from previous researchers, this study uses the movie Pinocchio (2022) as a research subject because this movie is a Disney 2022 movie. The movie received a lot of attention from many people around the world. There are many characters found in this movie that can influence the audience. Therefore, this study uses this movie as a research subject.

Although character traits have long been a topic of research, it is still considered less widely used as research material, especially in education. This is because it is not uncommon for children to imitate the behavior displayed in the films they watch. Because the topic of character is still very important to be researched to provide a deeper understanding of the character itself. So this research aims to examine the character of the main character in the movie Pinocchio (2022) based on the formulation of the problem as follows: 1). What are the characters of Pinocchio in the Pinocchio movie based on Robert Stanton's theory (1965)? Through this research, the attitudes of speakers and listeners towards the characters that have been found can later be used as material for building children's character both in formal and non-formal education.

METHODS

Participants / Subject / Population and Sample

This research uses descriptive qualitative research methods. (Maleong, 2010: 51) reveals that in qualitative descriptive research, the data collected are words and pictures, not numbers. It can be concluded that descriptive qualitative research is an activity in the form of analyzing a film and extracting information to obtain rough data whose results are more emphasized on data description. This research focuses on the character of Pinocchio in the movie Pinocchio (2022). The data of this research are movies and scripts downloaded from https://subslikescript.com/movie/Pinocchio-4593060. Furthermore, the researcher used Robert Stanton's (1965) theory of analysis, namely character words, character behavior, conversations between characters, and character actions to analyze the data found on the main character Pinocchio.

Instruments

As for the instrument or tool in the research of qualitative research was the researcher himself. Sugiono (2012: 195) states that the researcher will be the instrument, because in qualitative research the researcher is the key instrument. In this study, the researcher becomes a research instrument using Robert Stanton's theory by making direct observations of character development, namely characters words, characters

behavior, conversations between characters, and character actions by underlining dialogue or statements in Pinocchio (2022) movie.

Data Analysis Procedures

There were several steps followed by the researchers in this study. First of all, the researcher reviewing the data that has been collected. Next, the researcher determining the component parts of the main character. After determining the component parts, the researcher analyzing the characters found use Robert Stanton's theory 1965. The final step, the researcher drawing Conclusions based on data analysis

FINDINGS

The research results obtained in the form of a description of Pinocchio's character in Pinocchio (2022). The results of the analysis are divided into four according to Robert Stanton's theory (1965), namely, character's words, character behavior, conversations between characters, and character actions. Then the researcher gets some characters of the main character Pinocchio can be displayed in the following table:

Sub Findings

Based on the description of the results in the table above, in this section the researcher will discuss the Pinocchio (2022) movie which is the object of research to describe the character of the main character Pinocchio in the movie.

Character's Words

At this stage the researcher will use data that is based on the character's words. Said by Robert Stanton (1965) the researcher presents clues about the character

when the character speaks alone. At this stage the researcher will focus on when the main character speaks alone. The data obtained related to the main character is as follows:

Curiosity

Curiosity will always motivate oneself to continue to seek and know new things so that it will increase knowledge and experience in learning activities. In Oxford Dictionaries curiosity is a strong desire to know in doing something.

According to Robert Stanton (1965), in the meaning of analyzing the character of the main character according to behavior, the writer describes the behavior of a person such as his temperament, habits, or idiosyncrasies. Jiminy Cricket: "I hope I'm wrong, but that sure looks like Stromboli's to me. Quick. Under the pier. Look. It's Sofia. I got an idea. I'll paddle out and see if she knows which way Geppetto went. You keep out of sight."



The scene above shows that Pinocchio also has other obedient characters in the character's actions. Pinocchio obeys everything Jiminy Cricket says. This can be seen when Jiminy Cricket and Pinocchio see Strombolin's train walking towards them. Jiminy Cricket said to Pinocchio that Pinocchio should immediately hide under the bridge to avoid Strombolin's. When telling Pinocchio to hide Jiminy Cricket saw a bird and he told Pinocchio that he would meet the bird to ask for Geppetto's whereabouts and while asking for his help. The researcher found that the obedient character is not only found in the primary data part of the conversation between characters, but also in the secondary data part of the character's actions because the main character Pinocchio shows his character through character actions.

Loving

Furthermore loving, the word loving is the root word of the word darling which means love, compassion. Every living being has a heart that is sincere in loving others. In Oxford Dictionaries loving feeling or showing love and care for someone/something.

The scene above shows that Pinocchio has a loving character. Geppetto is everything to Pinocchio. This can be seen when Pinocchio quickly saves Geppetto who is drowning due to the waves. Researcher found that Pinocchio's loving character is not only found in the secondary data part of the character's actions, but also in the primary data part of the conversation between characters.

Helpful

Helpful is a light-hearted nature that is always ready to help anyone who needs our help. In Oxford Dictionaries helpful is making it easier or possible for someone to do something by doing something for them or by giving them something they need.

The scene above shows that Pinocchio has a helpful character. This can be seen when Pinocchio's actions are trying to save Jiminy Cricket who is separated from them. And the action that Pinocchio did was finally able to save Jiminy Cricket. Researcher found that Pinocchio's helpful character is only found in the secondary data part of the character's actions, because the main character Pinocchio shows a helpful character through his actions.

DISCUSSION

From the above results, researcher found that there are 15 Pinocchio characters contained in Pinocchio (2022), namely Loving, Obedient, Curiosity, Naive, Cheerful, Worried, Lying, Brave, Friendly, Intelligent, Optimistic, Responsible, Helpful, Fearful, and Disobedient. By loving which amounted to 5 in the category of conversations between characters, Obedient 5 in conversations between characters 4 and the actions of character 1, Curiosity 4 in the category of conversations between characters 3 and the words of character 1, Naive 4 in the category of conversations between characters 3 and the habits of character 1, Cheerful 1 in the category of character habits, worried 4 in the category of conversations between characters 3 and the words of character 1, Lying 4 in the category of conversations between characters, Brave 2 in the category of character actions, Friendly 3 in the category of conversations between characters, Intelligent 2 in the category of character actions, Optimistic 2 in the category of conversations between characters, Responsible 2 in the category of conversations between characters, Helpful 1 in the category of character actions, Fearful 1 in the category of character words, and Disobedient 8 in the category of conversations between characters and characters behavior. With a total of 49 found.

Based on the results of research using Robert Stanton's (1965), researcher found that Pinocchio has characters that lead to positive characters and negative characters. Positive characters and worthy of emulation include loving, obedient, curiosity, cheerful, worrying, brave, honest, and intelligent characters. While negative characters and not worthy of emulation include naïve, lying, and disobedient characters.

Pinocchio's most dominant character is the disobedient character. Disobedient character is a behavior that is deliberately shown by children, either actively or passively, not to take actions in accordance with the requests of parents or other authority figures. In the Oxford Dictionaries, disobedience is failing or refusing to obey someone/something. In some of the scenes above, Pinocchio always disobeys the words of his father Geppetto and Jiminy Cricket. Meanwhile, the characters that researcher

encountered the least were Cheerful, Helpful, and Fearful. Cheerful character appears a little because only in scene 5, when Pinocchio is on the theater stage, Pinocchio shows his happiness when performing in front of many people and to become famous. Furthermore, fearful, feaful character is excessive fear, so it does not dare to take risks or face danger. The reason for the fearful character is slightly found, because Pinocchio's character is described as a brave character in facing various problems and risks. And helpful character also appear a little because the character is only shown when Jiminy calls Pinocchio and Pinocchio immediately extends his help to Jiminy Cricket.

Previous study that is similar to the research to be carried out is Rizky Tungga. T. T. with his journal thesis entitled Analysis of the Main Character and Description of the Author's Life in Charles Dickens' David Copperfiels Novel. In this thesis journal, the researcher focuses on analyzing the main character in the novel David Copperfield. The researcher used Robert Stanton's (1965) theory to identify and analyze the main character through words, behaviors, conversations, and actions. The results of this study show that the main character's personality is diligent, rigid, innocent, hardworking, romantic, loyal and loving.

Related to the previous research object, Rizky Tungga. T.T. uses novels and Rober Stanton's theory (1965) to analyze the main character. In contrast to researcher who use Pinocchio (2022) movie as the object of research and Robert Stantont's theory (1965) to analyze the main character. Although this movie is part of the Walt Disney label, it has never been studied before.

CONCLUSIONS

The Pinocchio (2022) movie gives us many lessons about character education. Pinocchio is a character who is famous for lying. And it is true that in this study researcher found many Pinocchio character that lead to lying characters. However, even though we know Pinocchio has a character who likes to lie, in reality in this movie the lying character is not as much as the obedient character that researcher found in Pinocchio. Based on the results of research using Robert Stanton's (1965), researcher found that Pinocchio has 15 characters, namely Disobedient, Obedient, Loving, Curiosity, Naive, Worried, Lying, Friendly, Brave, Intelligent, Optimistic, Responsible, Cheerful, Helpful, and Fearful. With a total 49.

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
